Unknown to anyone my newly purchased bull had a birth defect that did not allow him to do his job and Phil refunded my money immediately with no hassle. Again, that is what I call "100% guarantee".

Phil's honesty is another big plus when you are buying bulls from him. Whenever you ask him a question, the answer will be one hundred percent honesty, even if the answer is not favorable to his sale.

Phil does not stop with just guaranteeing his bulls. Over the years he has helped me market my calves, worked to teach me how to grade my animals and made many financial suggestions to improve my operation.
